- · Material safety details

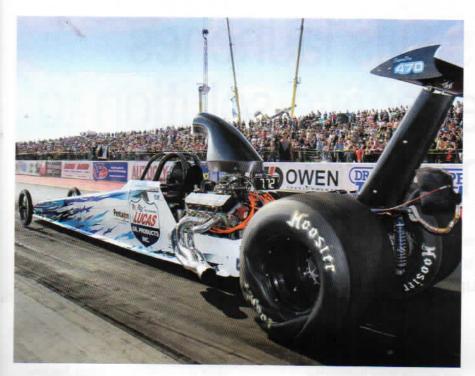
- · Technical data sheets

Lucas Oil's website is continuing to provide product news and direct access to its online catalogue, RRPs and online sales. Meanwhile, the company is also giving its direct technical support a services a higher priority, Les claimed.

"When it comes to selecting the most appropriate oil for a particular application, there's no substitute for an available telephone technical hotline that goes direct to the supplier."

The hope is that all these combined moves will increase support to all motor factors and enhance your confidence



levels, especially those with 'close associations' with motorsport - whether directly linked through sponsorship or indirectly connected through contact with racing teams run or served by your garage customers.

As well as the need to be aware about the oil requirements of UK car parc, you need to be able deal with enquiries about production cars that have been adapted for racing competition, as well as specialist vehicles that have been developed for regular competition in specific racing categories.

"Motor factors are not diagnosticians; garages need their product knowledge. What this does is ensure it's always available when they need to supply it," added Les.
